

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting

Held in the Village Hall, Barmby Moor

Matters Arising from Previous Minutes:

Upgrading Street Lights – to use grant of £2364.00. Sub-Committee meeting on 27 September at 7.30 pm in the Village Hall.

Code of Conduct - letters sent to MP's Greg Knight and Eric Pickles plus Legal & Democratic Services at ERYC. Advice given from ERNLCA.

Queens Diamond Jubilee Seat – Malcolm McClure has agreed to site at a cost of £70.00.

Bus Shelters – thicker Perspex yet to be purchased.

Yorkshire Water (Pumping Station) – clerk contacted Yorkshire Electricity, they have checked the site and not their responsibility. Try Yorkshire Water again.

Road surface outside the Post Office – Cllr Spencer explained how Ian Gatenby had done a temporary repair with road fillings. LW West Construction will excavate and tarmac part of the horseshoe road at a cost of £1408.00 in the near future.

School Parking – Cllr Laverack will arrange a meeting with the new Head Teacher between the Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

A1079 speed limit and condition or road/B1246 speed reduction – clerk to arrange an on-site meeting with Phillip Hiscott ERYC.

Barmby Feast (North's Fairs) – quotation from Malcolm McClure to repair grass ruts (£250). Cllr Woods will ask the Playing Fields Committee for a donation towards the repairs.

County Mile Project – grass has been cut on the wildlife area and seeds planted ready for 2013.

Cleaning the Bus Shelters – 3 applications received. Cllr. Spencer will interview each applicant and decide the most suitable. Members happy for Cllr Spencer to make this decision.

Schedule of Works from Taskforce – spreadsheet for outstanding works. Clerk and Chairman added further observations for work still required.

Local Development Framework – Fast Checking Exercise 2012 – observations submitted relating to development within Barmby Moor parish.

Gliding Club – suggestion from a Pocklington resident (Mr Cooper, 10 Barmby Road) to fly a red flag when flying is operational. This will protect walkers using the public footpath.
