

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting

held in the Village Hall, Barmby Moor

On Thursday, 11 April 2013 (commenced at 8.45 pm) – followed APM

Present: Councillors Spencer, Haynes, Van Dam, Shepherd, Laverack, West and Lane. Julia Gregory (Pocklington Post).

Apologies: received from Cllrs. Vass, Inglis, Woods and Pocklington.

Declaration of Interest from members on any item to be discussed: None.

Minutes: Consider approval of minutes of PC Meeting held on 21 February. Prop. Cllr. Shepherd, Sec. Cllr. Van Dam and carried.

Planning Meeting held on 25 March, Prop. Cllr. Haynes, Sec. Cllr. Laverack and motion carried.

Matters Arising:

Upgrading Street Lighting – no update from Mr.Jacobson.

Yorkshire Water – waiting for Inspectors report. Cllr. Spencer explained YW had lifted all the man holes and discovered the beck was running into the damaged sewers.

Parking outside the school – official complaint received from the Kid's Club who are experiencing dangerous situations for their children during transferring from school to the Kid's Club. Clerk to try and arrange meeting with Community Partnership.

Gliding Club – Cllr. Shepherd reported that a dog walker had been threatened using the footpath, and will report to the police.

Parish Magazine – first issue delivered with PC's report.

Pot hole repairs outside the PO – temporary repairs have been carried out by Ian Gatenby.

Keldspring Lane – road resurfacing to commence in May. Members thought Main Street needed re-surfacing before this Lane.

East Riding Local Draft Plan – no observations at the moment as still being circulated.

Sutton Lane – waiting for a reply on various issues.

Creating a Neighbourhood Plan – Cllrs. Spencer and Laverack happy to sit on this committee.

Condition of road verges – at Briarsfield, Becksides and Holborn Estate, waiting for a response.

Severe weather and Local Grant Fund – breakdown of grants received and funds used for purchasing salt and labour.

Isabel Malin – complaint about a horse using pedestrian/cycle path. Members preferred horse use the path as using the road would be dangerous.

Plans:

1. Brookfield Group, Petrol Filling Station on Industrial Estate – variation of condition 41 for approved plan – (C) – Female amenities need extending.

Planning Approvals:

1. Mr. Paul Bartram, Barmbyfield House, conversion of redundant farm building to hospitality facilities.
2. Mr. Fretwell-Bates, Pink Ladies, St Helen's Square – change of use from Village Store to garage.
3. Walker Grain Store, Industrial Estate – erection of grain store for crop storage.

Audit – forms received ready for District Audit.

Correspondence:

Footway Lighting Maintenance – Service Level 1 Agreement – Members agreed to renew Service Level agreement for 2013/14 = £3686-68. Prop. Cllr Haynes, seconded Cllr. Laverack and motion carried. Forms signed by the Chairman.

Keldspring Lane – resurfacing work to commence during May.

West Wolds Radio Ltd – community radio applying for a licence.

Temporary road closure – Hodsaw Lane was closed 9 April for 21 days, to facilitate emergency repair to a burst water main.

Cllr. Haynes reported the next Calley Trust Trip is on the 17 June to Bridlington and Flamborough.

Ice melt/Grit to purchase – members agreed clerk can purchase grit etc., approx cost £300.00.
