

**Minutes of a Planning Meeting held on Wednesday, 15 January 2014**

**Plans:**

- 1. Robinson, Greenlands Warren, Sutton Lane – erection of detached building for office/staff facilities (E)**
  - The building is over built for the purpose of office and staff facilities.
  - If approved there should be agricultural restrictions.
  - Also if approved should have temporary planning consent.
  
- 2. Harrison-Little, Endymion Cottage, Sutton Lane – (E)**
  - Consider original Planning Officers decision on the initial plan should stand. Why after enforcement proceedings should amended plans be submitted? Members prefer this be reviewed by a committee.
