### Matters arising from the previous meeting:

**Boot & Slipper** – Andy Tennant is proposing to erect a marquee with a possible screen inside. There will also be screens of the race inside the pub. He proposes to open all day, the Playing Fields Committee cannot do a BBQ so Andy will put food on in the pub, although it could be difficult to assess how many people will be attending. On the grassed corner he is erecting a bike with flowers.

**Parish Council** – Play Park will be dressed as will the bus shelters. Leaflets need distributing around the village.

**Pink Ladies Cycling Club** – a large screen was too expensive to hire. They propose to site cycles along the route. Val French happy to co-ordinate the work.

**Post Office** – Ken Middleton will hang out bunting and dress the grass verge in front of the PO.

**School & Toddler Group** – proposing to do Land Art within the school grounds and have entered a competition for this. Hopefully the pupils will attend after school. Hand flags might be considered.

**Craft Club** – brought to the meeting examples of t-shirt bunting. They are proposing to use wool and fabrics to decorate the village as well as hoops.

**Church and Craft Club** – considering putting a large yellow t-shirt on the church, also hoops to look like wheels on the church hedge. Gordon Fallowfield the church warden, happy for the church to be decorated.

**Bronya Emmison** – is arranging a large banner welcoming the cyclists into the village.

**Blue Bins** – Fran Johnson realizes he will need to order more than the 50 “yellow Y’s” for the wheelie bins, as we need to include Sutton Lane. It will be a good idea to hand out to individual householders who will be responsible for attaching to their bins on the day.

**Jan Gardham** – will hang bunting on the trees in Main Street.

**Sutton Lane** – a few residents have offered to hang bunting outside their homes. PC will need to leaflet the proposals.

**Hewson & Robinson’s Garage** – Val French has offered to have a word with the garage owners.

**Antique Centre** – Gregg Huber will paint a bike and a reliant robin on the roadside verge.

**Gliding Club** – clerk to get in touch to see if the club will get involved.

**Grant Application** – clerk to go ahead with the application.

**Best Dressed Village** – clerk to enter this competition.

**Road Closure** – clerk to apply to close St. Helen’s Square between 1400 until 2200 hours.

It was decided to commence the dressing etc., the weekend before the race (27 and 28 April).
