## **Parish Update**

**2017 Parish Council meeting dates** – 13 July, 24 August, 5 October, 16 November and 14 December. Please note the change of meeting day to a Thursday, and at the moment meetings will commence at 7.00 pm.

**Cold Calling** – Isabel Malin and Elizabeth Pepper have been handing out questionnaires to local residents in Main Street and Sutton Lane. Many thanks to Isabel and Elizabeth for their help in hopefully making these two areas No Cold Calling Zones.

Jody Nightingale from East Riding of Yorkshire Council Trading Standards, gave a talk at the Boot & Slipper's Community Coffee Morning at the beginning of May. This proved that parishioners in other parts of the village are interested in extending the No Cold Calling Zones. We will keep you updated on how this progresses.

**Annual Parish Meeting on the 20 April** – was well attended by over 30 people. Councillor Andy Burton (ERYC Highways and Transportation Chairman) gave a very informative talk on Highway problems in the parish. Various issues were discussed including speed reduction, traffic calming, parking near the school during pickup and drop off times, highway verges and the works being carried out between Pocklington and Barmby Moor (B1246).

**Barmby Moor Neighbourhood Development Plan** – Councillor Stephen Clark gave an update on the present situation regarding the NDP at the Annual Parish meeting. A breakdown of information from the questionnaire has been completed and can be seen or downloaded from the Parish Council's website.

**Condition of the road in Main Street (B1246)** – Councillor A. Burton ERYC has confirmed that after the repairs have been completed, surface dressing will be carried out during the summer.

**Grass verges** – Please do not park on the village green or highway verges, we have such a pretty village, do keep it neat and tidy.

**Village Awareness Defibrillator session** – as mentioned in the last update, parishioners were invited to an awareness session on how to use the Defibrillator. This took place in the Boot & Slipper on Thursday, 18 May and was well attended.

**St. Catherine's Church heating** – the Parish Council has given the PCC a grant of £5000 towards the church heating. This needed implementing before repairs to the church roof could be carried out.

**Barmby Moor School Parking (Holborn Estate)** – the Parish Council's request to tarmac the grass verge adjacent to the school has been rejected by the Schools Property Manager at ERYC. This issue was raised by local residents again at the Annual Parish Meeting, hence it will be on the agenda for discussion at the next PC meeting.

**Play Park, Main Street** – the PC has submitted a grant request for new play equipment from WREN. This will be for multi-play equipment for young and older children. Unfortunately at the moment the new basket swing cannot be used due to a broken nut and bolt. The problem has been reported to the supplier, and we are waiting for them to carry out the repair.

**102 (Ceylon) Squadron Association Re-Union** – was held on the 6 & 7 May. Barmby Moor Parish Council was represented by Cllr. J. Shepherd at both the dinner and church service.
