Parish Update

Annual Parish Council meeting – this is the meeting for parishioners of Barmby Moor, when you are invited to speak and raise issues relating to the parish. Hope **many** local residents will attend, so if there is a certain problem you would like answering, please get in touch with a Parish Councillor or the clerk so an answer can be prepared.

Tour de Yorkshire – will be going through Barmby Moor, York Road and Sutton Lane on Thursday, 2 May at approximately 16:30 hours (although this time will be confirmed nearer the race). We don't have exact times as they are driven by TV transmission times, but will be finalised by April.

A village meeting was well attended at the Boot & Slipper on the 11 March, when local groups and residents gave many ideas on how to make this a very special day for the village.

One idea is to put the blue wheelie bins out in Main Street and Sutton Lane, which can be decorated with a yellow "Y". Other ideas include dressing the street with yellow and blue bunting, bicycles and even yellow t-shirts. Groups involved are the Pink Ladies Cycling Club, Community Group, the Church, School, Toddlers Group, Craft Club, Village Hall, and the Post Office. Andy Tennant at the Boot & Slipper proposes to open for food and there will be other activities for everyone to enjoy.

The village dressing can also include the rest of the village, so please get involved and make this a very special day for the community.

The next Tour de Yorkshire village meeting is to be held on Monday, 25 March at 6.00 pm in the Boot & Slipper.

Dog Fouling – complaints received about dog fouling in Keldspring Lane and near the bus stop opposite the pub. Generally dog owners are very conscientious about cleaning up after their pets but unfortunately a few are not responsible dog owners.

Holborn Estate/The Orchard verge parking area – the costs for the proposed parking area at The Orchard/Holborn Estate verge was too expensive for the Parish Council to cover. It ended up only installing a parking area for 3 or 4 cars. Next step is for the PC to look at other options hopefully involving the school.

Telephone Kiosk/Red Box Library – Bring a book and take a book is a great success. Thank you to Felicity Beaumont for keeping the books in order.

Bus Lay-by A1079 outside Barmby Moor House/Constantine House – PC has received requests to erect a shelter at this bus stop. It will be the same as the one erected on the opposite side of the road. What are your views? Perhaps you can come to the Annual Parish Meeting to discuss this proposal.

Village Benches – another project is to erect three benches in the village to help people walking to the PO or bus stops. Proposed sites are: end of Briarsfield, near the Wildlife area and Back Lane. Again this will be discussed at the Annual Parish meeting.

Local Elections 2019 – will be held on the 2 May 2019. Parishioners who are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor please look out for the notices on the Parish Notice Boards, Barmby Moor's website and also this parish update.
